A Telecast on Rural Entrepreneurship and Innovative Leadership 3:00 P.M. - 4:00 P.M. EDT

As part of the Economic Development Administration's continuing commitment to growing rural economies, this telecast will focus on "Rural Entrepreneurship and Innovative Leadership." Rural America is home to nearly a quarter of the nation's people and research findings reveal that rural America performs differently than the rest of the U.S. economy due to the changing technological and global challenges. Rural development initiatives are critical components for America's global stability and competitiveness in the world wide economy helping to fuel regions throughout America. While traditional economic development strategies have struggled to yield outcomes in rural communities in an era of increased global competition, there has been an increased emphasis on rural entrepreneurship and innovation. The panelists will address the following:

- Research findings on building support systems for rural entrepreneurs
- Success stories of how rural communities have developed from within
- Examples of entrepreneurs that have benefited from their unique local assets
- Lessons learned for rural communities to strengthen their workforce and tap into a world wide economy

The telecast will feature the Kellogg Foundation which has been at the forefront of developing a framework for economic development practitioners who are trying to implement the best ideas about entrepreneurship in their rural places. The foundation panelist will provide examples of innovative leaders. Two rural businesses will provide their experience and progress as sustainable innovative leaders in their regions.
