Work involves analyzing user requirements, procedures, and problems to automate processing or to improve existing projects or services. Administers CAPCOG GIS shape files, geodatabases, and KML files using Access, ArcGIS, MapSAG, Plant Aries, and Google Earth. Assimilates data from multiple sources, formats, and projections into a CAPCOG compatible geospatial format. Creates original and collects existing geospatial data in a variety of sources including hard copy, text, tabular, database, and geospatial formats. **Education:** Graduation from an accredited four-year college or university with major course work in GIS, regional planning, geography, or related field is generally preferred. **Experience:** minimum 3 years experience as a GIS professional.
