

## **Transportation Planner**

Science Applications International Corporation's (SAIC) Transportation Solutions Division is seeking a Transportation Planner to provide assistance and leadership in the area of transportation planning for operations. This position will support projects under contract to the U.S. Department of Transportation (U.S. DOT) and may also include support to state departments of transportation and the National Academies of Science.

This position will contribute significantly to national level projects to advance planning for operations among metropolitan planning organizations and their planning partners including local and state departments of transportation and transit agencies. Work may include developing the conceptual foundations for this emerging area, researching and writing guidebooks to facilitate adoption of emerging approaches and/or incorporating best practices and lessons learned; writing brochures, developing and leading workshops and webinars for transportation planning and operations professionals; and other activities that assist regional planners and operators to adopt new approaches and effectively plan for operations. Transportation operations refers to activities to traveler information, traffic signal coordination, incident management, transit system management, freight mobility management, work zone coordination, and special events operations. Activities will involve regular interaction with clients, project management, and business development. The role may require occasional travel within the U.S. to support transportation –related meetings.

**Required Experience:** The candidate should have at least 7 years of applied experience in the area of metropolitan transportation planning including experience in the development of metropolitan transportation plans or long-range transportation plans for metropolitan planning organizations. The candidate should have expertise in the areas of transportation management and operations and/or congestion management and experience managing projects. The candidate must have strong professional writing experience.

**Desired Experience:** The ideal candidate would have an understanding at both a strategic and applied level of developing and using transportation system performance measures and associated data collection to guide operations activities and investment decisions. Experience writing proposals, developing business, and working directly with clients is desired.

### **Required skills:**

- Excellent written and oral communication skills.
- Detail-oriented, highly organized, and strong ability to multi-task.
- Ability to work independently as well as with small teams.
- Skilled at effectively coordinating and managing projects.
- Knowledge of Federal regulations for metropolitan transportation planning.

**Education:** Candidate must possess at least a Bachelor's degree in planning, public policy, or related area. Degrees in other fields may be considered when accompanied by highly relevant experience. Advanced degree is preferred.
