The position also includes similar responsibilities for transportation planning-related comprehensive planning. The department provides a full range of transportation, comprehensive and current planning services to its six member jurisdictions. The MPO is also the rural transportation planning agency for adjacent Carroll County.

The successful candidate will possess a Master's degree in transportation planning, transportation engineering, urban and regional planning, public administration, or related area, with a minimum of eight years of related experience; or a Baccalaureate degree in transportation planning, transportation engineering, urban and regional planning, public administration or related area, with a minimum of ten years related experience. Candidate must have at least two years of transportation planning experience at the MPO, state or federal level or one degree must be in transportation planning or urban and regional planning with a transportation emphasis.

Master's Degree and Certification by American Institute of Certified Planners preferred.

Superior writing and editing skills are required.

Previous experience with Microsoft Office software and GIS software; a working knowledge of TransCad is also preferred.
