- A Bachelor's Degree from an accredited college or university with a major in regional, urban or transportation planning, community development, public policy or a related field; and five (5) years of public agency experience in urban, regional, transit or transportation planning; OR
- A Master's Degree from an accredited college or university in majors listed above and two (2) years of progressively responsible professional regional, urban or transportation planning and project management experience.
