Disney Character Dining5

DISNEY SPRINGS

Located within walking distance from the host hotel. Reservations are recommended at restaurants marked with a *.

[Art Smith's Homecoming*](#) – This “Upscale Down South” restaurant features Celebrity Chef Art Smith’s farm-to-table Southern cuisine. Dishes include fried chicken, short ribs, fresh grouper, and chicken and dumplings.

[STK*](#) – STK is a modern steakhouse that also features a variety of seafood dishes.

[Edison*](#) - Designed to look like a 1920s electric company, The Edison features American cuisine, craft cocktails, and lively entertainment, such as contortionists, aerialists, and live cabaret. A dress code is enforced after 10pm.

[Raglan Road*](#) – An Irish pub offering food, four imported bars, and free nightly live entertainment.

[The Boathouse*](#) – An upscale waterfront dining experience, the restaurant features Florida surf and turf. The Boathouse marina offers private cruises, including vintage Amphicar tours, and a variety of festivities throughout the day.

[Morimoto Asia*](#) – Japanese master chef Masaharu Morimoto’s first “Pan-Asian” restaurant has a wide variety of Chinese, Japanese, and Korean dishes. The restaurant has a sushi bar on the 2nd floor.

[Polite Pig](#) – This quick-service restaurant has twists on barbeque favorites and adult beverages served on tap.

[Splitsville Luxury Lanes](#) - Splitsville is a modern take on a bowling alley. It is recommended to call ahead and reserve a lane.

[Aerophile](#) – A balloon ride that offers 360-degree views of Walt Disney World during an 8-10 minute flight in the world’s largest, hand-painted helium balloon.

[House of Blues](#) –The House of Blues offers a Sunday Gospel Brunch and an outdoor Front Porch bar with nightly entertainment.

[Bibbidi Bobbidi Boutique](#): Offers princess makeovers for girls ages 3-12. Reservations are highly recommended.

INTERNATIONAL DRIVE RESORT AREA

Approximately a 15-minute drive from the host hotel.

Outlets – More than 500 shops and outlets make this area a popular destination for shoppers. A few of the options include:

- Orlando Vineland Premium Outlets - 8200 Vineland Avenue, Orlando, FL 32821 (approximately 5-minute drive from host hotel)
- Orlando International Premium Outlets - 4951 International Drive, Orlando, FL 32819

I-Drive 360 - The Coca-Cola Orlando Eye's 400-foot observation wheel is the centerpiece of the complex, which has a blend of attractions, restaurants, and shops. 8375 International Drive, Orlando, FL 32819.

The Escape Game Orlando – One of many attractions in the I-Drive area, this game gives teams an hour to complete a mission and escape. 8145 International Drive, Suite 511, Orlando, FL 32819

Yardhouse – This restaurant/bar features the world's largest selection of beer and a menu of over 100 made-from-scratch menu items backed by a soundtrack of classic rock hits. 8367 International Drive, Orlando, FL 32819

Top Golf – Allows for groups to play a variety of golf games along with food, drinks, and TVs. 9295 Universal Boulevard, Orlando, FL 32819

OTHER AREAS TO EXPLORE

Universal Orlando/City Walk: Home to Universal Studios, the Universal Orlando complex also includes the Volcano Bay waterpark, Islands of Adventure, and CityWalk. Two Harry Potter-themed areas are also located within the complex.

Downtown Kissimmee/Lakefront Park – (15-minute drive from host hotel) Downtown Kissimmee offers a variety of shops, restaurants, and bars. Nearby Lakefront Park features a great playground for kids and an opportunity to watch nature and view the fishing docks and piers along beautiful Lake Toho.

Winter Garden – With a rich history in citrus, downtown Winter Garden has undergone significant revitalization in the last 10 years. The West Orange Bike Trail runs through downtown, bringing hundreds of people to restaurants and shops like Crooked Can Brewery and Plant Street Market.

Winter Park - Winter Park is home to Rollins College; the Charles Hosmer Morse Museum of Natural Art, which houses the world's most comprehensive collection of works by Louis Comfort Tiffany; and Park Avenue with its outdoor cafés, bistros, upscale specialty shops, and boutiques.

Mead Botanical Garden - This 48-acre urban oasis located in Winter Park features hiking trails, a greenhouse, a butterfly garden, and a pond that is home to turtles, fish, and wading birds. 1300 S. Denning Drive, Winter Park, FL 32789, 407-622-6323.

[Harry P. Leu Gardens](#) - A 50-acre botanical oasis with meandering trails shaded by 200-year-old oaks and forests of camellias, Leu Gardens is located minutes from Downtown Orlando. 1920 North Forest Avenue, Orlando, FL, 407-246-2620.

[Downtown Orlando/Lake Eola](#) - Downtown Orlando is home to the Amway Center, Orlando City Soccer Stadium, and much more. Lake Eola Park offers beautiful views of the Orlando skyline, paddleboat rides, and an almost one-mile-long walkway around the lake perimeter.

[Audubon Park Garden District](#) - A cluster of restaurants and shops along Corrine Drive in northeast Orange County. Highlights include East End Market, a food hall with more than 10 artisanal food vendors.

[Baldwin Park](#) - This new urbanist community sits on the site of a former naval training base and features a pedestrian-friendly Village Center with a variety of restaurants and shops.

[Kennedy Space Center](#) - Located an hour's drive from the host hotel, Kennedy Space Center has a unique history. Once home to the Space Shuttle program, the Center now launches a variety of satellites and rockets. The Visitor Complex is a must-see and houses the Atlantis Space Shuttle.

Beaches: The host hotel is within 90 minutes to both the Atlantic Ocean and Gulf of Mexico. Cape Canaveral/[Cocoa Beach](#) are the closest. [St. Petersburg/Clearwater](#), located on the Gulf of Mexico, are a 90-minute drive away.

GOLF

Over a dozen golf courses can be found within a short ride from the host hotel.

Golf at Walt Disney World:

- Lake Buena Vista Golf Course - Closest course to the host hotel
- Oak Trail Golf Course - 9-hole, Par 36 course
- Magnolia Golf Course - The longest of Disney's golf courses
- Palm Golf Course - Recently redesigned 18-hole championship course

The fees for the Disney courses start around \$50.
