The Commission is looking for a highly motivated individual interested in joining a diverse team of planners and engineers focused on ensuring that the Region is prepared to compete on a national and global scale economically while improving the quality of life for the Region's residents. The Land Use Planner will be a key staff member working in the Land Use Division to conduct and assist in the preparation of plans and reports and analysis and visualization of data. This is an excellent opportunity to bring urban design features into the Commission's renowned planning reports.

- Prepares maps, tables, charts, graphs, and other visual data as needed for reports
- Creates conceptual illustrations for Commission plans

Requirements:

- Ability to work within and contribute to a team structure and to work with diverse groups of individuals within diverse environments
