ORGANIZATION

The Stark County Regional Planning Commission (SCRPC) is a regional planning agency serving the greater Canton Ohio area. The SCRPC serves as the host agency for Stark County Area Transportation Study (SCATS), which serves as the region's Metropolitan Planning Organization. Last year, SCRPC/SCATS administered approximately \$20 million in federal and state funding for transportation, infrastructure and community development projects.

DESCRIPTION

The SCATS Technical Director is an advanced professional and technical position in transportation planning and engineering. This employee functions as the Technical Director of the Stark County Area Transportation Study (SCATS) and in that capacity is responsible for the design and supervision of all elements of the transportation planning program. This employee works under the administrative supervision of the Executive Director while exercising independent judgment for transportation engineering and related technical work elements.

RESPONSIBILITIES AND DUTIES

- Coordinates the activities of the MPO in carrying out the federally mandated continuing, cooperative, and comprehensive metropolitan transportation planning and programming process, including all supervisory, administrative, outreach and technical tasks.
- Prepares and/or supervises the preparation of all transportation engineering and technical data, designs and plans
- Provides technical and engineering expertise in related functional planning areas, including comprehensive planning, community development, and planning administration
- Reviews transportation planning goals, policies, plans and objectives
- Works with other agency staff in the development and implementation of the MPO's Unified Planning Work Program and budget
- Provide staff support to the MPO policy board, MPO technical committee; overseeing the MPO's public information and outreach activities and stakeholder engagement; serving as liaison to local, state, and federal agencies and organizations; and assuring compliance with federal transportation planning regulations.

QUALIFICATIONS

This position requires a Bachelor's or Master's degree in civil engineering, planning or a related field. A minimum of 5 to 7 years work-related experience, or equivalent combination of education and experience.

COMPENSATION
